Information on the conditions for processing personal data: according to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, which repeals Directive 95/46/EC (general regulation on data protection), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR" Operator: Žilina University in Žilina, ID: 00397563, Univerzitná 8215/1, 010 26 Žilina, hereinafter referred to as "UNIZA"

- The affected person acknowledges that UNIZA will process his/her personal data obtained for the purpose of conducting state exams.
- The purpose of processing personal data is to fulfill the obligations and tasks of UNIZA as a public university within the framework of the proper provision of state examinations.
- The legal basis for the processing is Article 6 para. 1 letter c) GDPR - processing is necessary for the fulfillment of UNIZA's legal obligations, arising mainly from Act no. 131/2002 Coll. on universities and on amendments to certain laws, including legal obligations of public universities established in case of a crisis situation, and Article 6 par. 1 letter e) GDPR - processing is necessary for the performance of tasks in the public interest. The public interest is considered to be the fulfillment of all legal conditions for holding a state exam, including the provision of public access to it. The provision of personal data for the purpose of holding a state exam is a legal requirement, while the consequence of not providing them is the impossibility of participating in the state exam.
- UNIZA archives and stores the personal data of the person concerned for the period determined by applicable legal regulations and internal regulations of the operator in accordance with the Registration Plan, which is an annex to the Registration Rules. In accordance with the provisions of the Law on Universities, the audio recording from the public part of the state exam will be available to the public for listening in the UNIZA premises for three months from the end of the crisis situation. After this period, UNIZA will ensure the deletion of the record.
- UNIZA informs the affected person about the following rights arising from the GDPR and Act no. 18/2018 Coll. on the protection of personal data (hereinafter referred to as the "Law"): a) the right to request from UNIZA access to the provided personal data, the right to obtain confirmation that its personal data is being processed and the right to related information pursuant to Article 15 of the GDPR, b) the right to correct personal data in case of incorrect or incomplete personal data according to Art. 16 GDPR, c) the right to delete personal data, if the legal prerequisites enabling the deletion of personal data are met ("right to be forgotten") according to Art. 17 GDPR, d) the right to limit the processing of personal data, if the legal prerequisites for limiting the processing of personal data are met according to Art. 18 GDPR, e) the right to portability of personal data provided to UNIZA, if the legal prerequisites enabling the portability of personal data are met according to Art. 20 GDPR, f) the right to object to the processing of personal data, which is carried out on the basis of a legitimate interest according to Article 6 par. 1 letter f) GDPR and the contact details of the responsible person, g) the right to submit a proposal to the Office for the Protection of Personal Data, the purpose of which is to find out whether there has been a violation of the rights of natural persons in the processing of their personal data or there has been a violation of the applicable legislation according to section § 100 of the Act,
- UNIZA confirms that personal data is not processed through automated individual decision-making and profiling.
